Significant Winter Storm Forecast for the Sierra - Be Snowsmart!

- NWS Reno has issued a Winter Storm Warning in effect from 10pm Saturday (2/3) to 10am, Monday (2/5).
- Snowfall rates of 1-3" per hour in the Sierra will lead to whiteout conditions and hazardous travel.
- Highest snowfall totals are favoring Mono County with a 90-95% probability of 3+ feet, with 4 feet along the Sierra crest.
